Dear Mr. Powell:

I have received the Notice of Inactive Hazardous Substance or Waste Disposal Site for the property referenced above. The plat has been approved by the Division of Waste Management and is being returned to you for recordation.

Within fifteen (15) days of your receipt of this letter, Mills Gap Road Associates must file the original executed mylar plat with the Buncombe County Register of Deeds office, and send to my attention: 1. a *certified copy* of the recorded plat, i.e., a paper copy of the plat as it is stored on microfilm/microfiche, affixed with the original seal and signature of the Register of Deeds and reflecting the book and page number where recorded; and 2. a photocopy of the page from the grantor index where the plat has been indexed. If the Buncombe County Register of Deeds office does not store survey plats on microfilm/microfiche, Mills Gap Road Associates should submit a paper copy of the original mylar plat, affixed with the original signature and seal of the Register of Deeds and reflecting the book and page number where recorded.
